

## **Next Steps**

See the Change – Tanzania July 7 – 13, 2024

This trip will be a transformative experience that will deepen your knowledge of Landesa's work and contribute to a more meaningful philanthropic journey. Thank you for traveling with us! Below are several next steps to follow in preparation for our Tanzanian adventure:

- Payments: In order to formally secure your place on the trip, a deposit of \$500 is due to Landesa. The final payment (\$4,000 per person for double occupancy, \$4,500 for single occupancy) is due by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 2) **Begin looking for flights:** Please plan to arrive in Arusha, Tanzania by Sunday, July 7<sup>th</sup> for a group Welcome Dinner that evening. If arriving at **Kilimanjaro International Airport**, a driver will greet you and transport you to our arrival hotel, <u>Kibo Palace Hotel</u> in Arusha. The trip ends on Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup> in Stone Town, Zanzibar, at which time you can book a flight home via **Abeid Amani Karume International Airport**, or continue travel at your leisure.
- 3) **Travel documents:** Be sure to check that your passport will be valid for 6 months <u>after</u> the date that travel commences and has sufficient pages to accommodate entry/exit stamps and necessary visas. A visa is required to travel to Tanzania. Please visit <u>www.immigration.go.tz</u> to learn more about travel requirements and obtaining a visa.
- 4) Travel/Medical Insurance: Make sure your health insurance plan provides coverage overseas. Most care providers overseas only accept cash payments. Visit the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for more information on what type of insurance you should consider before you travel overseas. Supplemental insurance to cover medical evacuation is strongly recommended by the CDC.
- 5) **Medical:** Check with your physician before traveling to be sure you are up to date on all necessary vaccinations or other travel health precautions. Note: In addition to your travel first aid kit, always carry your prescription medication in original packaging, along with a copy of your doctor's prescription.
